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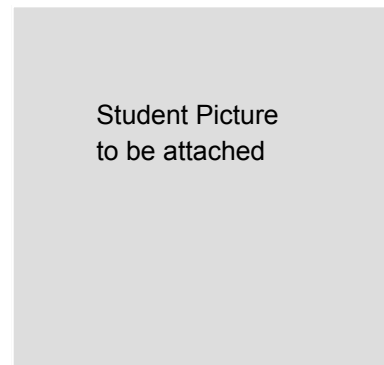

Steps:

Examples of Actions:

- Call Ambulance - phone number - how long to wait to arrive?
- Travel by ambulance/car? Persons escorting child?
- Administer medication/CPR immediately.

- School call to parent/emergency contact - numbers
- Send a runner to notify teacher and principal
- Medical authorization form
