FAMILY MOVIE NIGHT

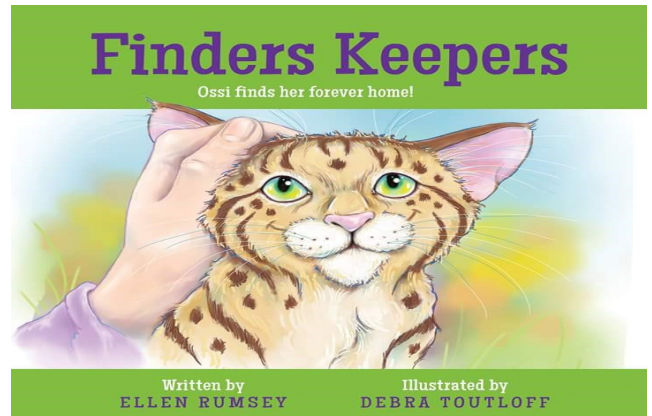
