our school, our community and the world?

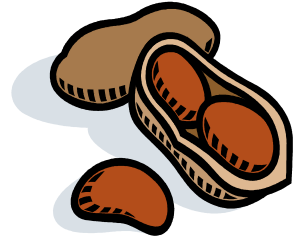
Peanut Sensitive School

Please continue to check labels carefully and please ensure products with nuts do not come to school or are eaten on the bus. We want to support one another and respect health conditions in our school community. We appreciate your concern and cooperation.

WOW butter, a peanut butter replacement product, is not permitted within our school. Please ensure that your child does not bring this product in his/her lunch or other products that look identical to peanut butter. We do not want to confuse the issue with these products.

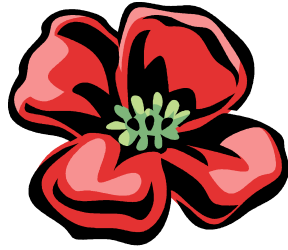
School Bus Cancellations:

Anyone can subscribe for email notifications for general notices, school closures and route cancellations & delays. You must first confirm that you have a valid email address.

To subscribe go to the above site, click on the "Subscriptions" icon, then click on "Subscribe". Enter your email address and press the "Subscribe" button. You will receive an email confirmation containing a link that you will need to click to complete the subscription process.
